You must provide everything for your booth including linens. Electricity will be available by request. Caterers may bring food but will need to provide proper documentation and must follow the Vendor rules.

VENDOR TABLES

As an option (limited) vendors can choose a 6-ft table instead of a full booth. This is for the vendor who doesn't have much. We only have a limited amount available.

VENDORS - Vendors must supply an email and will be notified of all vendor information once reservation is confirmed from Tracey Moro - Editor@macombnowmagazine.com. You will be kept updated as to ticket sales and any other info you may need including ways to promote the event and receive a discount for advertising in the 2021 Macomb Vow Bridal Guide. All Vendors must be respectful of Macomb College and its facility's rules.

SETUP - Vendors must use authorized loading and unloading areas and park in the main parking lot once you are unloaded. The circle drive in front of the Lorenzo Cultural Center may be used for loading and unloading only. Cars left unattended in the circle drive for an extended period of time will be ticketed. Early set up will be available on Saturday, October 3, 2020. Event day set up begins at 9 am. If you require special attention please call ahead - 586-212-1673. Take down will begin at 4:15 p.m. - no sooner.

BOOTH LOCATION - Macomb Now will determine the placement of all vendors and reserves the right to reject vendors or limit vendors in any category. We will assign space on a first pay first serve basis - meaning a contract with a deposit is the ONLY way to reserve space. We will do our best to limit categories and keep like vendors separated. No booth sharing is allowed.

TABLES - Each 6-foot table will have 1 chair provided. Tables are limited. Once we run out we reserve the right to reject or offer you a full size booth. Tables will be reserved as contracts and deposits are received.

FOOD PROVIDERS - If you are a caterer and plan to have food samples available at your booth you must be approved by Macomb Community College Event planning first by providing the proper documentation and licenses. The MCC Kitchen will NOT be available for use. There is no cooking on open flames or propane allowed in the facility. No hot plates, hot boxes, or heating elements allowed. You must provide your own self contained food service station. Chaffers are allowed for food warming. You are responsible for your own food storage containers, refrigeration of food, cooking, presentation and serving. You also must provide small plates, bowls, napkins and disposable flatware as needed. Documents needed for MCC - Copy of your current Macomb County Health Department License and copy of your current Basic Insurance Liability. You must also sign a release of liability and indemnity agreement with MCC. All forms are available on the MacombNow-Magazine.com website for you to download and sign. MCC also suggests you have a list of ingredients for anyone with food allergies.

DOOR PRIZES - Prizes donated should be at least a \$50 dollar value and are not required. It is an opportunity for more promotion of your company at our event. These will be given out to brides at the show randomly.

BRIDAL BAGS - Vendors with booths or tables can supply giveaways for the Bridal Bags and entry registration table. Giveaways must be received by Thursday, October 1, 2020 at Macomb Now offices - 18901 15 Mile, Clinton Township between Groesbeck and Kelly. Use the front door near the flag pole. We suggest at least 200 quantity. You can always pick up what is left at the end of the show.
